


# CHILD CARE ILLNESS REPORTING

Sick child?

Yes

Record on Illness Log



Do symptoms require exclusion?

No

Contact parent/guardian to notify of child's symptoms.

Yes

Separate child from group and contact parent/guardian to pick up child. In the event of a vomiting incident, children should be removed from the area until **Body Fluid Cleanup Steps** have been completed.

If symptoms worsen

- In areas where the child has been:
1. Use the Body Fluid Cleanup kit (aka barf bucket) to clean up spills if needed.
  2. **Clean and disinfect** surfaces that may be contaminated.
  3. **Clean and sanitize** mouthed items
  4. Launder soft items.

Provide parent/guardian **illness documentation** and requirements to return to care (24 hours symptom free without medication).

Don't Forget

Check the **Illness Log**.

3 or more children/staff in a group with diarrhea or vomiting in the last 72 hours, one case of bloody diarrhea OR a child/staff in the last week diagnosed with a **reportable disease**.
