





84TH FROM SANDALWOOD TO ELIZABETH



PROJECT SUMMARY

Lincoln on the Move is investing in improvements to 84th Street from Sandalwood Drive to Elizabeth Drive. These improvements include a mill and overlay of the existing surface and concrete repairs. Additional work with other funding sources includes pavement markings and upgrades to the existing curb ramps to comply with the Federal Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) requirements.

CONSTRUCTION SCHEDULE

This project is expected to begin construction in Spring 2023 and continue until Winter 2023.




ACCESS DURING CONSTRUCTION


Construction of 84th will be completed in segments to reduce impacts to traffic. However, there will be times when certain directions of travel and/or lanes will be closed to through traffic. Access to individual properties will be maintained as the construction process allows. The traveling public is encouraged to find alternative routes and to use the WAZE app for assistance. Curb ramps and sidewalk repairs will be phased so that the MoPac and 84th St Trails will always be accessible to bicyclists and pedestrians through the use of modified routes.



FUNDING DETAILS

This project is programmed as a part of the commitment to voters to invest significant sales tax funds into improvement of existing streets. The total project estimate is \$4,120,000 and will be funded jointly by the 1/4 cent Lincoln on the Move sales tax in accordance with ballot language and Highway Allocation Funds (aka Gas Tax).





The public is encouraged to identify any special accommodations that may be needed during construction and to make suggestions or express concerns regarding this proposed project. Comments will be collected through **March 16, 2023.**
