DEFINE Parking on O Street between 21st - 27th Street

 Incorporate curb bulb-outs to define parallel parking spaces along East O Street.

 Introduce street trees and understory planting with the space gained by introducing bulb-outs.

 Eliminate underutilized parking spaces and replace with planting and pedestrian public realm space.
