

# **Darryl W. McSwain**

Chief Darryl McSwain was appointed as the Chief of Police for the Maryland-National Capital Park Police – Montgomery County Division - in May of 2018. He has emphasized a collaborative approach to community engagement and was recently inducted into the Montgomery County Human Rights Hall of Fame for decades of “visionary leadership, outstanding achievements and altruism on the road to advancing human rights.” Prior to this appointment, Chief McSwain was a member of the Montgomery County Department of Police for 30-years before retiring as an Assistant Chief where he led the Field Services Bureau which consists of County Security, Media Services, the Crisis Response & Support Division, Animal Services, and Traffic Operations. Previous assignments also included: Supervisor of the Community Outreach Section, Investigative Services Bureau Administrative Supervisor, Director of the Internal Affairs Division, Commander of the 1<sup>st</sup> District Station, Director of the Special Operations Division, and the Patrol Services Bureau Assistant Chief. He is a member of the International Association of Chiefs of Police and the Police Executive Research Forum.

Chief McSwain obtained his Bachelor of Arts Degree in Criminal Justice from the University of Maryland and earned a Master’s Degree in Administrative Management from Bowie State University. Chief McSwain is an alumnus of the Major Cities Chiefs Association *Police Executive Leadership Institute* and graduate of the F.B.I. National Academy and National Executive Institute. He and his wife Sallye are the proud parents of four young adults.
