Director Advisories

Liz Elliott:

- Sidewalk update: reviewed annual report
 - o 85% increase in locations repaired compared to prior year
 - o Ramps nearly 3x 2024 as of now, additional expected
 - o Coordinating and partnering with StarTran, focusing on school/walk areas to maximize beneficial usage of funds
 - o Reimbursement program for residential owners increased from \$6/square foot to \$10, resulting in large increase in homeowner participation
 - o Relies on resident reporting for finding issues,
 - o Assessments typically complete within 48 hours of resident report

- o Spray-tag colors are used to designate grinding vs. replacement
- Data collected, repairs added to batch sets for efficiency rather than spot-byspot
- o 5-year backlog expected to shrink significantly over next 3 years
