

NOTICE OF INTENT TO ISSUE PERMIT

Lincoln-Lancaster County Health Department (LLCHD)

- A. In accordance with Article 2, Section 14 of the Lincoln-Lancaster County Air Pollution Control Program Regulations and Standards (LLCAPPRS) and 40 CFR Part 72, §72.72 paragraph (b)(1)(iii), the LLCHD gives notice of the preliminary determination to approve the following permitting action(s) for the source identified in item 'B' (below). The 30-day public comment period commences April 5, 2024 and ends on May 5, 2024.
1. Proposed renewal of a Phase II Acid Rain permit.
- B. Issuance of the proposed permit allows for continued operation of the subject emission source within Federal, State and Local requirements. Provided below are the name, address, and the North America Industry Classification System (NAICS) code(s) describing the nature of business at the subject emission source:
1. Source Name: Lincoln Electric System – Terry Bundy Generating Station
 2. Source Location: 7707 Bluff Road, Lincoln, Lancaster County, Nebraska 68517
 3. NAICS Codes: 221112 (Fossil Fuel Electric Power Generation)
- C. The proposed Phase 2 Acid Rain permit will not result in a change of the subject emission source's current potential to emit. This permit is being issued to establish enforceable conditions that require the source to perform control measures already in use at the source.

Within the 30-day public comment period, any interested person, agency, or group may submit comments on the proposed permit(s), or request or petition the Director of the LLCHD for a public hearing in accordance with item 'F' below. Comments on the proposed permit(s) may be mailed to the attention of the Air Quality Program Supervisor at the address provided in item 'D' above, or submitted via e-mail to health@lincoln.ne.gov using the subject line 'Comment on Air Quality Permit'. Individuals commenting via e-mail are asked to provide their home address and phone number for follow-up correspondence.
- F. Requests for public hearing must be made in writing, and must state the nature of the issues to be raised and all arguments and factual grounds supporting their position. If a public hearing is granted by the Director, the hearing will be advertised by public notice at least 30 days prior to its occurrence.
