	<b>Community Improvement Grant</b>	<b>Neighborhood Association Grant</b>
<b>What's the big difference?</b>	Incentive to make my community better	Reimbursement of expenses
<b>Who can apply?</b>	Groups or individuals	Neighborhood associations or Lancaster County Villages
<b>Where does the cleanup occur?</b>	Cleanup of public roads or public open spaces.	In designated neighborhoods or villages.
<b>How much funding can I get?</b>	Incentive is based on the miles of roadway or acres of public space cleaned and reporting.	Reimbursement is based on approved expenses and reporting.
<b>What can the money be used for?</b>	These funds can be used as desired.	Examples include roll-off dumpster rentals, landfill fees, tire recycling costs, equipment rental, etc.
<b>When is the application period?</b>	February 1 <sup>st</sup> – October 31 <sup>st</sup>	February 1 <sup>st</sup> – October 31 <sup>st</sup>
<b>When is the final report due?</b>	Within one month of the cleanup.	Within one month of the cleanup.
<b>Where is the funding from?</b>	Nebraska Department of Environment and Energy	City of Lincoln
