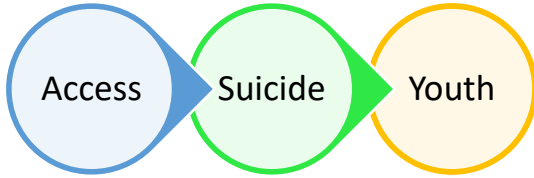

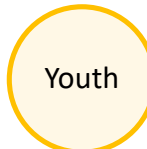

As a CHIP Team we have worked with Coalitions and Community Partners, providing a process that delivers planning, priority setting, and Workgroup development. Through our team's initial Environmental Scans, strong efforts were identified addressing some or all of the priorities for a CHIP focus.

1. Access to Behavioral Health - Environmental Scan in 2022
2. Peer Support Utilization - Scheduling a full Environmental Scan for late summer 2023 – Wellbeing Initiative
3. MYLINK - Don't Panic Labs (w/ Bryan Seck) – Reworking to better provide CHIP-aligned info for under-resourced community members – **This is a major partnership that will impact most of the CHIP workgroups**
4. Certified Community Behavioral Health Centers (CCBHC) Support – This is a new model to Lincoln as of 2019 that builds from Behavioral health services, adding a primary care component. Lincoln houses 2 of the 5 in Nebraska: CenterPointe and Health 360 (both received a second round of Federal funding in addition to new State legislation). LB 276 was passed with strong bipartisan support. This act will also allow for researching the viability of stable Medicaid funding/support.
