

The City of Lincoln will hold a public open house regarding a proposed roundabout at 56th and Yankee Hill Road. The purpose of the project is to mitigate crashes and improve traffic operations at 56th and Yankee Hill intersection. Based on the traffic study and analysis completed, the preferred alternative is to construct a roundabout at this intersection. This project would be constructed under a full closure and would utilize a detour for traffic on South 56th Street and Yankee Hill Road. The Yankee Hill Road detour would use South 40th Street, Pine Lake Road and South 70th Street. The 56th Street detour would use Saltillo Road, South 70th Street and Pine Lake Road. Access to adjacent properties would be maintained during construction but may be limited at times due to phasing requirements. The project would require the acquisition of additional property rights which could include new right-of-way (ROW), temporary easements (TE), and permanent easements (PE) throughout the project area.

The public is encouraged to make suggestions or express concerns regarding this proposed project. Comments will be collected through September 26, 2018.
