

HSIP-5241(6) 56TH AND YANKEE HILL RD, LINCOLN; C.N. 13347; CITY PROJECT NO. 702884

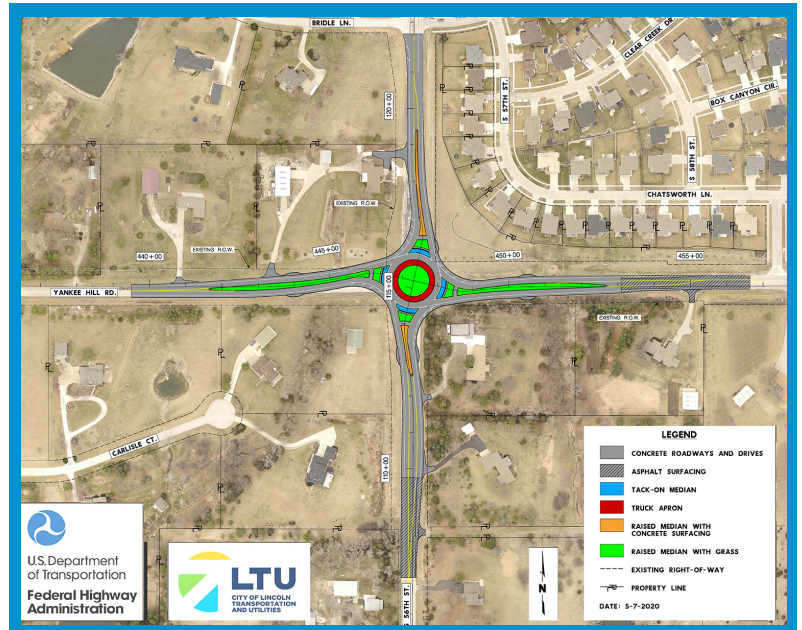
The City of Lincoln will hold a virtual pre-construction public information meeting regarding proposed improvements of the intersection of South 56th Street and Yankee Hill Road, in Lincoln, Lancaster County. The meeting will be held online at www.lincoln.ne.gov (keyword: yankee hill) beginning June 4, 2020.

A roundabout was selected as the preferred alternative that best met the project's purpose and need.

Construction of a roundabout requires reconstruction of the approach roadways that would extend approximately 0.25 miles east and west of the intersection along Yankee Hill Road and approximately 0.25 miles north and south of the intersection along South 56th Street. Drainage and storm sewer improvements will also occur.

Construction is anticipated to begin mid-June with the work substantially complete and open to traffic by November 2020. This project will be constructed under a full closure and would utilize marked detours.

Yankee Hill Road Detour

South 40th Street, Pine Lake Road and South 70th Street will be used for detouring through traffic on Yankee Hill Road.



S. 56th Street Detour

Saltillo Road, South 70th Street and Pine Lake Road will be used for detouring through traffic on South 56th Street.



Access to Adjacent Properties

Local access to driveways is allowed during all phases of construction. The contractor will provide advance notice to property owners before any impact.



Projects in the Vicinity

A separate City of Lincoln Citywide Arterial Rehab (2020) project (City Project No. 701879) located at S. 56th Street from Bridle Lane to Thompson Creek Boulevard in Lincoln, Lancaster County is located within the project vicinity. Construction on the Arterial Rehab project is anticipated to start in June 2020 and be completed in September 2020. Message signs would be used for advance notification of all closures, including those at minor intersections.
