## Transportation and Utilities Application for Use of Public Right of Way Permit



Per LMC 14.54 Occupancy Above or Below Public Property, an Application for Use Public Right of Way Permit must be submitted in writing to the Director of Lincoln Transportation and Utilities (LTU) or designee. The Application must include the property address, the total square footage of encroachment and the intended use.

The following items must be submitted with the Application: construction drawings, continuing bond in the sum of not less than \$5,000.00; public liability insurance; and a current certificate of insurance.

Any person aggrieved by the Department in the denial of an application for a permit shall have the right to appeal to City Council by filing with the City Clerk a notice of appeal within 14 days of denial.
