

# Corrugated cardboard is not garbage.

Starting **APRIL 1, 2018**, recycle it!

**After April 1, the landfill will not accept clean and dry corrugated cardboard.**

Corrugated cardboard (pictured below) is defined as three or more layers of paper with the middle layer rippled or corrugated. It is the most common recyclable material disposed in the city landfill.



Join the team that does the right thing, and take it to the recycling bin! Recycling cardboard instead of throwing it away reduces garbage at the landfill and preserves natural resources.

You can take cardboard to public recycling drop-off sites for free, or sign up for convenient curbside pickup.
