Bagging your grass clippings robs your lawn of nutrients. Grasscycling, or leaving grass clippings on your lawn, feeds the worms and adds organic matter to your soil. This reduces the need for fertilizers and prevents excess nutrients from washing into our local waterways.

Remember to keep grass clippings out of our storm drains by sweeping them off of the street and back onto your lawn.
