

# PAVEMENT REMOVAL

## REIMBURSABLE EXPENSES



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- Rental equipment fees for removing 100 ft<sup>2</sup> or more of unwanted pavement and replacing with vegetation or a permeable paver system (e.g. jackhammer, concrete saw, skid loader, excavator, etc.)
- Soil amendments (e.g. compost, topsoil, etc.) to increase soil fertility and infiltration rate
- Approved native plants or turfgrass planted in previously paved areas
- Permeable paver system, including reservoir-related materials, replacing a previously paved area
- Design and installation labor performed by a landscape company or contractor
- Attendance of a stormwater workshop or educational class

### NON-REIMBURSABLE EXPENSES

- Unapproved plants including annuals, vegetables, and invasive species
- Non-permeable pavers, bricks, and concrete
- Pavement removal projects in areas not subject to stormwater runoff (e.g. covered patio, driveway inside a carport, etc.)
- Ornamental features (e.g. railings, stairs, statues, landscape lighting, etc.)
- Tool purchases (e.g. rakes, shovels, wheelbarrows, power tools, etc.)
- Retaining walls or raised garden beds
- Water or other utility bills, gasoline, etc.
- Design and installation labor done by the homeowner or a non-professional
- Additional landscaping or dirtwork that does not pertain to the rainscaping projects
- Expenses for work performed or projects completed prior to acceptance into the program
