## REIMBURSABLE EXPENSES



### REIMBURSABLE EXPENSES

- Rental equipment fees for removing existing lawn and preparing the seed bed (e.g. rototiller, sod cutter, etc.)
- Soil amendments (e.g. compost, topsoil, etc.) to increase soil fertility and infiltration rate
- Soil grading to redirect and slow the flow of water moving across the lawn
- Approved native or deep rooting turfgrass (e.g. buffalograss, blue grama, fine fescues, etc.) seed, hydroseed, or plugs to establish a new lawn
- Design and installation labor performed by a landscape company or contractor
- Attendance of a stormwater workshop or educational class

### NON-REIMBURSABLE EXPENSES

- Overseeding an existing lawn
- Unapproved turfgrasses including shallow rooting and water intensive species, as well as species inappropriate for our area (e.g. bluegrass, perennial ryegrass, zoysia, etc.)
- Sod
- Tool purchases (e.g. rakes, shovels, wheelbarrows, power tools, etc.)
- Irrigation equipment including hoses and sprinklers
- Water or other utility bills, gasoline, etc.
- Design and installation labor done by the homeowner or a non-professional
- Additional landscaping or dirtwork that does not pertain to the rainscaping projects
- Expenses for work performed or projects completed prior to acceptance into the program
