ITEM 2: Expansion Plans, Lincoln Children's Zoo

Representatives of the Lincoln Children's Zoo and of Lincoln Parks and Recreation Dept. will attend the July 12th meeting to present and discuss the Master Plan for Zoo expansion within Antelope Park. As this is a major project with complex interactions with trails, the Rose Garden, the Strolling Garden, the Chet Ager Building, etc., the Zoo and Parks representative have penciled in the August 2nd UDC meeting as well, if the Committee wishes to invite them to return for a further update and discussion.

Item 3: Union College campus entryway feature (48th & Prescott)

Union College is developing plans for a campus entryway feature on the east side of S. 48th Street at Prescott. The concept includes both private land and public right-of-way (sidewalks) on both the north and south sides of Prescott. A use-of-right-of-way permit would be necessary to complete the overall concept, and Urban Design Committee is asked to advise on such permits when they have urban design impact. Union College will be invited to present their ideas to UDC at the July 12th meeting, if they are sufficiently developed for meaningful feedback.

Item 4: Staff Report and miscellaneous

We will provide an update on projects recently reviewed by the Committee, and "forecasts" as to when some of the matters to be jointly reviewed with Historic Preservation Commission might be scheduled.
