To Lancaster Planning and County Commissioners:

I am submitting several comments relative to my total objection to wind turbines being installed in the south western corner of Lancaster County.

Southern Lancaster County is a high density population area comprised of many acreages, interspersed with farm ground and it does not make sense to shoe horn wind turbines into this type of area. Wind turbines are better served if they are located further away from the suburban area of Lincoln to more wide open agriculture space areas.

The set back proposals for wind turbines should stay totally within the property lines of participating property owners and not be allowed to infringe on non participating owners. When set backs are allowed to infringe on non participating property owners, it impacts certain future uses of their property.
