The level of control notated is the highest level of control that was utilized for apprehension of the subject. Officers will often have to move through a progression of control levels, which is dictated by the level of resistance presented by the subject and effectiveness of the control techniques.

Medical is required for any subject exposed to a taser deployment. Use of control reports are required and completed for each officer involved in a qualifying incident, rather than per subject of the control. Therefore, statistical data regarding subject injury as a result of a use of control may be duplicated.
