

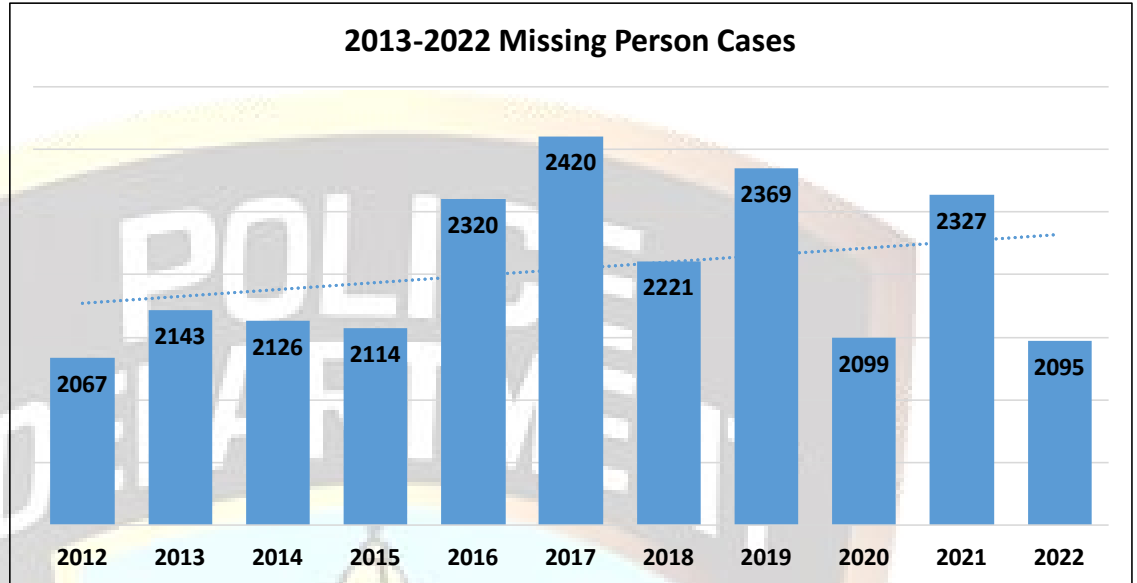

Missing Person Metrics 2022

Race:

- White = 55.2%
- Black = 27.1%
- Hispanic = 9.2%
- Unknown = 3.8%
- Native American = 3.3%
- Asian = 1.5%

Gender:

- Females = 49.4%
- Males = 50.6%

Miscellaneous:

- **65.8% of all Missing Person cases were cleared within ONE day.**
- **99.3% Clearance rate**
- Top 10 Missing Persons = 157 Cases (7.5%)
 - 3 Juveniles account for 56 cases.
- Top 20 Missing Persons = 271 Cases (12.9%)
- Top 40 Missing Persons = 444 Cases (21.2%)
