Since 2018, 22.9% of sexual assault cases **reported** to LPD occurred at least one year prior to the reported date, compared to 10.7% from 2000-2015.

Defining Table 1:

- Reported = Cases reported to LPD, which include “unfounded” cases (Different then FBI UCR totals as listed on table 2)
- 1 Year = Number of cases reported to LPD more than one year from the date the incident occurred
- Average = Number of days between the reported date and the date the incident occurred
- Median = Value at the midpoint of all the values
- Percentage = The number of cases reported more than one year after the date the incident occurred, compared to the total number of reported cases
