



# Larceny from Autos

As the weather gets warmer and the nights are nicer, Larceny From Autos historically see increases. Here are some helpful hints to stop thieves from breaking into your car and getting valuable items.

1. Lock the Car!
2. Remove ALL valuables from the car!
3. Remove the keys from the car. Do not leave them inside the vehicle with it unlocked.
4. Do not leave spare keys nearby where you park your vehicle (i.e. in the garage or attached to the vehicle somewhere).
5. Park in well-lit areas.
6. Install a tracker in your car.

Completing these six steps can help decrease the chances that you are the victim of larceny from auto. Please make it harder for the thief to take anything!

4. Do not share personal information online.

7. Do not keep secrets from your parents or guardians!
8. Teach children about calling 911.
9. Basic Water Safety
