With the Fall, comes Football! It is that time of year again to travel downtown to the stadium on Saturdays. We have some brief tips for you if you venture downtown on a game day!

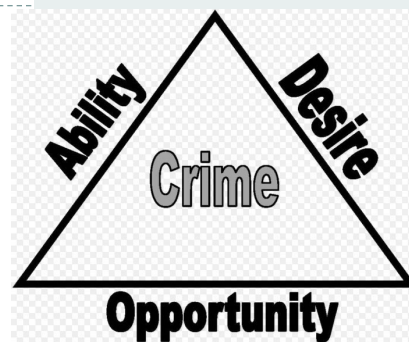
1. Plan ahead. Know where your parking lots are!
