

## BUS CLEANER

### NATURE OF WORK

This is unskilled work cleaning buses and other automotive equipment.

Work involves responsibility for cleaning the interior and exterior surfaces of municipal buses and other automotive equipment. Supervision is received from a bus mechanic or other higher-level superior with work being reviewed through inspections of equipment cleaned.

### EXAMPLES OF WORK PERFORMED

Washes and cleans both interior and exterior surfaces of buses and other automotive equipment including wheels and engine compartments.

Operates buses or other automotive equipment throughout entire cleaning process.

Cleans exterior of buses for special charters or in preparation for painting.

Keeps work area clean and organized.

Notifies supervisor of damage to vehicle observed through cleaning process.

Maintains routine records on daily work activities performed.

Performs related work as required.

### DESIRABLE KNOWLEDGE, ABILITIES AND SKILLS

Some knowledge of bus and automotive equipment cleaning methods and procedures.

Some knowledge of the tools, materials and methods used in cleaning buses and other automotive equipment.

Ability to drive and park buses and other automotive equipment.

Ability to understand and effectively carry out routine oral and written instructions.

Ability to maintain routine records.

Skill in the use and care of required tools and equipment utilized in the cleaning process.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

Graduation from high school or equivalent plus six months of experience in cleaning automotive equipment or any equivalent combination of training and experience that provides the desirable knowledge, abilities and skills.

NECESSARY SPECIAL REQUIREMENT

Possession of a valid driver's license when operating a vehicle is necessary to the satisfactory performance of assigned duties.

When operating equipment that falls under the Nebraska Commercial Driver's License (CDL) status, the employee is required to possess and maintain the proper license and endorsement.
