Proposed improvements include:

- new pavement
- roundabout intersections
- street lighting
- enclosed storm-sewer system
- concrete pads at bus stops
- ADA accessible sidewalks
- new driveway connections
- a multi-use trail

Members of the project team will be available to answer questions and provide an overview of the project, as well as information on the planned improvements, the phasing and the construction schedule.
