FHWA/FTA Approval of Amendment 2 to the Nebraska FY 2022 - 2025 Statewide Transportation Improvement Program

This letter is to inform you of the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) and Federal Transit review and approval of the highway and transit projects contained in Amendment 2 to the Nebraska Department of Transportation (NDOT) FY 2022 -2025 Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP). Amendment 2 to the FY 2022 - 2025 STIP approval incorporates amendments to the Lincoln Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) TIP, the Metropolitan Area Planning Agency (MAPA) TIP, and the Grand Island Area Metropolitan Planning Organization (GIAMPO). NDOT received one comment on the proposed Amendment 2 to FY 2022 – 2025 STIP during the public comment period. The comment did not pertain to a project or the program of projects, but to the format of the STIP document itself. NDOT responded directly to the commentor on December 22, 2021.

The Lincoln MPO Officials Committee approved Amendment 2 to the Lincoln MPO TIP on December 15, 2021. NDOT found Amendment 2 to the Lincoln MPO TIP to be fiscally constrained and in accordance with the Lincoln MPO public participation plan. NDOT approved the Lincoln MPO TIP Amendment 2 for inclusion into the NDOT STIP on December 16, 2021.

The MAPA Board of Directors approved Amendment 2 to the MAPA TIP on December 9, 2021. NDOT found Amendment 2 to the MAPA TIP to be fiscally constrained and in accordance with the MAPA public participation plan. NDOT approved the MAPA TIP Amendment 2 for inclusion into the NDOT STIP on December 16, 2021.

The GIAMPO Policy Board approved Amendment 1 to the GIAMPO TIP on November 23, 2021. NDOT found Amendment 1 to the GIAMPO TIP to be fiscally constrained and in accordance with the GIAMPO public participation plan. NDOT approved the GIAMPO TIP Amendment 1 for inclusion in the NDOT STIP on December 2, 2021.

In accordance with 23 CFR Part 450.218(b) and 23 CFR Part 450.334(a), FHWA has determined that the highway projects included in the Amendment 2 to the FY 2022-2025 STIP are based on

a transportation planning process that substantially meets the requirements. Based on the FHWA review of the FY 2022 - 2025 STIP, monitoring activities throughout the year, the MPO's self-certifications, and the planning finding, Amendment 2 to the FY 2022-2025 STIP is hereby approved.

Lincoln MPO Resolution: 2021-10 FOR THE PURPOSE OF ADOPTING THE TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM AMENDMENT

WHEREAS, the Lincoln Metropolitan Planning Organization (Lincoln MPO) is the designated Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) responsible for undertaking the transportation planning process for the Lincoln Metropolitan Transportation Management Area (TMA), in accordance with 23 U.S.C. 134, 49 U.S.C. 5303, and 23 CFR Part 450; and

WHEREAS, the Lincoln MPO, pursuant to 23 CFR 450.326, adopted on May 17, 2021 a Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) for federal Fiscal Years (FY) 2022 through 2025; and

WHEREAS, the Lincoln MPO has prepared an amendment to the MPO FY 2022-2025 TIP that adds one Nebraska Department of Transportation project, adds one City of Lincoln & Utilities Department project, and modifies an existing Lancaster County Engineering project as identified in Exhibit A; and

WHEREAS, these projects included in the amendment are consistent with the currently adopted MPO Long Range Transportation Plan, 2040 Long Range Transportation Plan - 2016 Update and/or the proposed MPO Long Range Transportation Plan, 2050 Long Range Transportation Plan (scheduled for MPO adoption on December 15, 2021); and

WHEREAS, the amendment has been reviewed and recommended for adoption by the Technical Committee of the MPO, and now requires adoption from the Officials Committee of the MPO.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Lincoln Metropolitan Planning Organization Officials Committee adopts the amendment to the MPO FY 2022-2025 Transportation Improvement Program.
