

NORTHEAST AND SOUTHEAST TEAM 'O' STREET ENFORCEMENT DETAILS

2018: Partnered with NSP Troopers on two occasions. A total of 50.5 hours of OT among 29 officers resulting in 92 officials, 166 warnings, 4 misdemeanor arrests and 2 DUI's.

2019: Partnered with NSP Troopers on two occasions. A total of 43.5 hours of OT resulting in 65 officials, 177 warnings, 6 felony arrests and 4 misdemeanor arrests. In addition, three SE Team Officers dedicated time during their normal shift to traffic enforcement on 'O' Street resulting in 85 official and 28 warning citations.

2020: Three separate POP (Problem Oriented Policing) projects were conducted to address traffic and trespassing violations resulting in 157 officials, 444 warnings (verbal and written) and 17 trespassing citations.



NORTHEAST AND SOUTHEAST TEAM 'O' STREET ENFORCEMENT DETAILS

- 2021: Three POP projects were conducted resulting in 155 officials, 87 warnings and 2 DUI's.
- 2022: Thus far in 2022, the Northeast Team has conducted 7 different traffic projects resulting in 72 officials, 18 warnings, 24 trespassing violations, 1 DUI and 1 vandalism citation.
- The Southeast Team currently has 2 POP Projects underway and have issued 16 officials and 6 warnings.
