ANIMAL LICENSE APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

Any person within the city limits who owns a dog or cat over 6 months of age is required to obtain a license for their pet. Rabies vaccinations are required at 3 months of age per state statutes and municipal code.

1. If submitting your application electronically to obtain a **new** pet license **or** to **renew** a pet license, please go to www.lincoln.ne.gov/City/Departments/Health-Department/Animal-Control/Permits-Licensing and follow the on-line instructions. You may complete and submit all necessary forms and payment through our on-line application.
2. If submitting by USPS, you may fill out this form on line and then print the application. Enclose the completed form, a non-returnable copy of the rabies vaccination, spay/neuter verification (if applicable) and the corresponding fees shown within the application fee table. Mail the envelope and entire contents with appropriate postage to:

**Please note: Licenses can also be processed in person by following step 2 and bringing the documents to our office at 3131 'O' Street (rather than mailing) during office hours listed at the top of this application.

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Any person within the city limits who owns a dog or cat over 6 months of age is required to obtain a license for their pet. Rabies vaccinations are required at 3 months of age per state statutes and municipal code.

- Email a completed application attaching a picture of the current rabies certificate. If your pet has been spayed or neutered, please include that verification. If using USPS, enclose the completed application, a non-returnable copy of the rabies vaccination and spay/neuter verification.
- Municipal code requires you to notify us if you no longer have your pet. Please call 402-441-7900.
- Fees payable to **ANIMAL CONTROL**.
- Please allow 2 - 3 weeks for processing via USPS.
- If your pet has a microchip, write the number next to the pet's name.

- License tags are not transferable from one owner or animal to another. Lost tags are replaced for \$5.00, if your pet is currently licensed.
- A license fee may be prorated for your convenience.
- Put the tag on your pet's collar!
- A rabies tag is not a license. With a license, Animal Control can contact you if pet is lost or injured.
