

SECTION 24. SULFUR COMPOUND EMISSION STANDARDS FOR EXISTING SOURCES.

- (A) No person shall allow sulfur oxides to be emitted from any existing fossil fuel burning equipment in excess of two and one half (2.5) pounds per million British thermal units (lbs/MMBtu) heat input, maximum two (2) hour average.

- (B) For the purpose of these regulations:
 - (1) “Existing fossil fuel burning equipment” means equipment, machines, devices, articles, contrivances, or installations in operation prior to February 26, 1974; and
 - (2) The heat input shall be the aggregate heat content of all fuels whose products of combustion pass through a stack, or the equipment manufacturer’s or designer’s guaranteed maximum input, whichever is greater.
